Types of Evidence

- **Real** – aka physical evidence; it is relevant and material to the crime and usually can be produced in court.
- **Demonstrative** - demonstrates or illustrates the testimony of a witness.
- **Documentary** - a kind of real evidence associated with human language.
- **Direct** - testimonial evidence of witnesses that ties the offender to the crime.
- **Circumstantial** - based not on personal knowledge, but rather an inference.
